Out of Session Motion

By email 23rd February 2026

1. Tine Adams moved *that the Mustard Seed Management Committee be authorised to increase the prices at the Mustard Seed as per the email from Sally Prickett on 21st February 2026.* Seconded by Tom Sheard. Carried.
